Methodology

APRE conducted a desk-based analysis of previous projects that engaged multiple stakeholders in the technology sector. Our review examined the strengths and weaknesses of various engagement methodologies within this specific context, focusing on challenges related to dialogue between experts and non-experts, as well as dialogue under conditions of unpredictability, which are common in the field of emerging technologies.

Lessons learnt
